

Insurance & Reinsurance 2016: Analysis

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5 Jun 2017 : This year's book sees 683 names endorsed from 321 firms opposite 56 countries.

Clyde Co once again leads a investigate with 25 practitioners highlighted for their word expertise. The firm's London bureau has 3 lawyers recommended, including Andrew Holderness who is a tellurian conduct of a corporate word group. He focuses his use on corporate financial in a word zone and has believe in flotations, MA and corner ventures, and is a "powerhouse of knowledge". David Abbott is co-head of a tellurian reinsurance use with specialism in domestic and trade credit risk. He has acted for a London marketplace in a series of new vast waste and is an "exceptional talent". Nigel Brook focuses his use on ubiquitous word and reinsurance disputes and is remarkable for his "creative solutions".
